Grant Burge Sparkling This is a classic aperitif style. The palate is slightly earthy, with orange blossom and peach sherbet flavours. It finishes lively and dry. Natural acidity leaves the mouth fresh ... cork

Grant Burge Sparkling Red Lovely fruit sweetness coupled with drying tannins, and creamy red fruits ... cork

Grant Burge Blanc De Noirs is a yeasty, elegant wine. A hint of strawberry here, set in a bed of bread yeast. Fine bead and creamy texture ... cork

Cool Woods Sparkling has fast become a favourite as it is creamy, strawberry laden and with excellent texture. Not surprising give it is made by Thorn Clarke ... cork

Drift Sauvignon Blanc We'd like to think we are too urbane to make dodgy puns but sadly we're mistaken. 'Adrift in a sea of innocuous Sauv Blanc? Sick of wetting you whistle when the mainsail is yet to be hoist? Lift anchor me hearties and drift on the trade winds to Drift SB. Seriously though, good stuff, cat spray, greenery and good intensity ... screwcap
Bonus Jade Bay SB on 6

Grant Burge GB SSB is a good quaffer. Light with good flavour and texture. Great quaffing with antipasto on a lazy weekend, or as an accompaniment to a quick weekday meal ... screwcap

Masia Subirana Xarel-Lo is a beautifully textured, fragrant Spanish white. Stacks up very well against homegrown whites in the same price range and definitely is a little different without being confronting ... screwcap

Bird in Hand Chardonnay The Birds just keep getting better. This is a seriously refined, tight chardy with excellent creaminess and oak handling ... screwcap

Mountadam High Eden Chardonnay A beauty, Phillip White rates it consistently as one of the best 10 Chardies in OZ. Well worth a rip ... screwcap

Tscharke Moscato Frizzante, or lightly bubbly, sweet and with excellent a grade fruit, this is a perfect accompaniment to a fruit salad, or a cheese plate. I see muscatels, Lavosh, Blue cheese and dried pear... screwcap

Black Chook Sparkling Shiraz is serious splurgundy, full bodied and layered with red and black fruits, tightly structured and finished with a responsible addition of sugar. Ben Riggs at his brilliant best... Screwcap.

Leconfield Old Vines Riesling is their best to date - and a trophy and gold medal winner to boot. Intense fresh lime with an undercurrent of caramelisation backed by a stack of lemony and sherbety goodness... screwcap **Bonus Claymore Riesling on 6**

Claymore Riesling screams Clare! Not because she's in danger, rather to share her magnificence. Lemony and limey overtones here, shot through with the bath powder ethereality that the best Clare Rieslings share. While this wine will age gracefully it is not an acid riddled enamel scourer. The acid is perfectly poised, making this wine a joy right now and over the next 5 years. Magnificent. Oysters or paté on toast ... screwcap

Babich Wakefield Downs SB is a superb and richly textured SB. Best of the best from Babich ... screwcap

Turkey Flat Rose with **96 Halliday points**, makes sense that this is one of the few vineyards dedicated at its outset to rose production. Made from Grenache, Shiraz, Cab and Dolcetto and is exceptional. Exquisite red fruits, strawberry and spice. ... screwcap.

Drift Pinot Here's a fleshy, easy drinking pinot, bedecked with red fruit and cherries... screwcap

Rabbit Ranch Pinot Central Otago has a staggering reputation for producing lean, mean and mighty fine pinots, at very high price points. So here's one at a more modest price with decent fruit intensity and texture ... screwcap

Water Wheel Shiraz Sometimes someone else says it better than we ever could. "Thunderous heart-starting stuff, so thick it could be spread on bread!" -Financial Review ... steel helmet (screwcap)

Water Wheel Petit Verdot Amazing intensity for a wine of this price, with blackberries, currants etc all wrapped up in sweet oak. An absolute ripper ... screwcap

Water Wheel Memsie Red Here's the less showy sibling, the quiet achiever. Lacking the extroverted nature of its stronger, bigger brothers, this is nonetheless exceptional value. Won a trophy in Victoria and is WineWise magazines Champion red blend award. No mean feat ... screwcap

Murray Street Black Label Shiraz A philosopher once said life is meant to be nasty, brutish and short. This wine qualifies on the first two counts, but gets Meatloafed out on the third. ZZ Top would likely suggest it has 'legs'. Incredibly intense fruit and blacker than Motorheads ace of spades ... cork

Murray Street Shiraz If the wine above is James Brown on PCP, this is Hugh Jackman on Broadway ... screwcap **Bonus Murray St SGM on 6**

Murray Street Barossa SGM We love this wine. An unusual blend, containing Cinsault, this is nonetheless a gorgeous Barossan. Where the Timbre of the above 2 wines differs only in degree of gravel, (both being equally sensitively oaked) This is a smooth crooner. Think Bob Downe doing Dean Martin. That's Amore! ... screwcap **Bonus Henry's Drive Shiraz on 6**

Tonic Fountain of Youth Shiraz Wanna know what Wine Showcase mag has to say about Tonic Shiraz?? "Huge, brooding, complex nose and a powerful fruit driven palate with good use of oak. This wine has good intensity and complexity and a lasting finish." I was on their tasting panel and reckon this beauty is the closest thing to Grange I've tasted in a while... tempted? Bonus Murray St SGM on 6

Grant Burge GB Shiraz A good quaffer, plenty of ripe, generous fruit and very easy to drink ... screwcap

Leconfield Cab In full pomp, a benchmark Coonawarra cab, full of power without ever approaching coarse or clumsy. Blackcurrant, cedar, etc. Screwcap

Claymore Dark Side of the Moon Shiraz These guys are definitely rising stars. Not well enough known yet to have the reputation they will eventually enjoy. This, their best and most underpriced wine is very well known. Sublime dark fruits wax a well structured pallet finishing with fine tannins. Slippery and succulent ... screwcap **Bonus Murray St SGM on 6**

Gemtree Uncut Shiraz is an intelligent brute that has been to finishing school. Knuckle dusters polished and shelved for a special occasion, he will charm rather than fleece, persuade rather than pester ... screwcap

Gemtree Bloodstone Shiraz This is a rich, soft chewy red offering plenty of juicy and jubey fruit, nestled in warm, furry tannins. This is the perfect richly fruited red for a still bleeding steak and will improve for many years.

Heirloom Shiraz is a beautifully crafted Eden Valley Shiraz offering intense black and blue fruits, quality oak and a lengthy finish. These guys clearly know how to make good booze... Well worth pondering its merits whilst enjoying marinated lamb backstrap ... screwcap. **Bonus Turkey Flat Mourved on 6**

Mountadam Barossa Shiraz is a beauty... rich thick chocolaty goodness set in a quivering mass of black and blue fruit jelly. The kind of wine that puts you in mind of a succulent roast lamb, and then desert. Maybe a little quality after dinner recreation. Anyone for cards? ... screwcap

Rymill MC2 is a beautifully balanced blend of cab, merlot and cab franc. Medium bodied it offers ripe mulberries and blueberries in that sweet/savoury fashion that Coonawarra does so well... screwcap

Turkey Flat Shiraz 07 is made in part from Shiraz vines dating back to 1847! This is an incredibly concentrated wine, loaded with blackberries, blue berries and Christmas cake all shot through with tarry goodness... brilliant... screwcap. **Bonus Murray St Barossa 94/100 Halliday on 6**

Sinclair Cabernet Shiraz is a top quaffer. Bolstered by around 30% cool climate fruit, this quaffer offer rich black fruits supported by well defined acidity and sweetness of fruit ... screwcap
